

Michel VERJUX

Biography

Since 1983, Michel Verjux (born 1956 in Chalon-sur-Saône in Burgundy) has been developing his *éclairages*, light sculptures composed mostly of projections, which he uses to intervene in architectural structures. Verjux studied under Jaume Xifra at the École nationale supérieure des Beaux-Arts in Dijon. He lives and works in Paris. He is also the co-founder of the center for contemporary art Le Consortium in Dijon. In addition to numerous permanent indoor and outdoor projects, his work has been shown at institutions around the world, including the Biennale for International Light Art in 2010, FIAC at the Grand Palais in Paris and MiArt in Milan. After his solo exhibition at the Kunstmuseum St. Gallen in 1994, his projections outside the Lokremise mark his second exhibition in St. Gallen.
